

Hearing scheduled for \$137,000 allegedly embezzled from bank

HUNTINGTON — Federal prosecutors have asked the court to schedule a plea hearing in the alleged embezzlement of \$137,000 from City National Bank.

The U.S. Attorney's Office filed the embezzlement charge against Lesa R. Fuller this month. Prosecutors asked Tuesday for a plea hearing to be scheduled. Their request indicates a guilty plea is pending. The information, which is

typically a charge that precedes a pre-indictment guilty plea, states Fuller embezzled approximately \$137,000. The money was taken between October 2003 and May 2006 from a Huntington branch of City National Bank. Fuller was

an employee at the time. Fuller's attorney, John A. Proctor, declined comment Wednesday.
